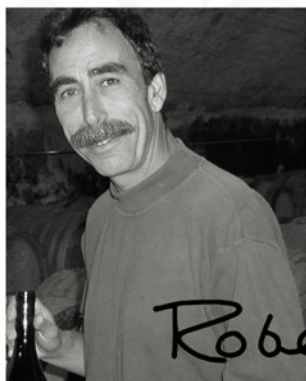

Background

The Montravel region of France is located just east of Bordeaux. Chateau Puy-Servain is owned by Daniel Hecquet, one of the regions best and most innovative winemakers who worked at Chateau Y'quem before coming home to Puy-Servain. Hecquet is known throughout greater Bordeaux for producing among the highest quality white wines in the appellation.

This wine is made primarily from Semillon, with a dash of Sauvignon Blanc. This wine is made completely from grapes affected by Botrytis Cinerea or Noble Rot. It is fermented and aged in small barrels for up to one year. You will find this wine very much like Sauternes displaying lots of upfront dried apricot fruit and raisin character mixed with bright orange peel and spice. This is certainly one of the finest dessert wine values to be found.
